

Dear New Vendor,

Thank you for your interest to join our Sunday Market.

This market is a NON profit market its about Supporting Local trade, Artisan (hand made), Organic and sustainable products, promote health and inspire other Farmers to start growing Organic around Bali.

In order to join we need to assure that everyone who participates come with the right product and attitude. We can still offer a space but no stalls as all our stalls are used by our original vendors who has been with us from the beginning, you need to bring your own table and umbrella, we do not offer storage space so you need to remove it by the end of the market day

To join the market we need you to read and understand which circumstances we apply

:

- 1.The products offered are made/grown by the vendor and not resell.
2. You use only Organic produce and sustainable production. We understand that if someone is making ready made food etc it can be difficult to use 100% organic produce but we encourage no less then 80%. If selling fresh produce, vegetables fruit etc, all needs to be Organic 100%.
3. That the vendor at the market is a legal person, and takes full responsibility to represent the supplier, we cannot offer stalls to expats without KITAS (work permit)
4. First day you come to register and pay a monthly fee to make a commitment to come 4 weeks a 300,000 IDR payment needs to be done at the Samadi Shop before we start the market.
5. The vendors should be present and ready to sell by 8:45 a.m., market closes at 2 pm we kindly ask all the vendors to stay until the end, unless sold out of course.
6. Depending on product and required space, vendors will be sharing

their stalls, and get to use half a table or sometimes less if smaller space required.

7. All vendors are asked to help spread the word about the market, invite friends, post on Facebook, emails, hang poster/flyer or which ever way it can be done to support each other and promote the mission of this market, to support local organic farmers and inspire those around them, to buy locally, to bring community together.

8. We are not responsible for tables that are not Samadi Stalls, all tables need to be removed at the end of the market day.
